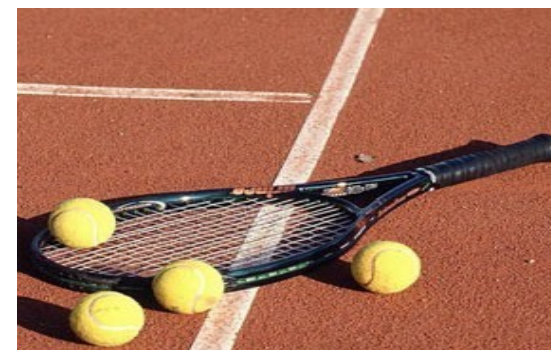
DUMFRIES TENNIS CLUB

New and existing members.

Welcome to Dumfries Tennis Club which is the main club in South West Scotland and has operated from the Nunholm grounds for 130 years. It still retains its family atmosphere and offers something for every standard of player.

The four courts are all weather synthetic grass with full floodlighting which enables you to play all year round. There is a courtside pavilion with a small kitchen, changing and toilet facilities. Whilst the main sports club has shower areas for both ladies and gents.



The club runs various events throughout the year.

The club currently runs two club nights through the summer months.

Monday club nights run from April until September and are open to senior and junior members who have the ability to play doubles matches. The sessions start from 6-30pm and run until approximately 8-30pm.

Thursday club nights are new and currently run from June until late August and from next year will be open to all senior members and again is set up for doubles matches. The sessions start at 7pm.

The box leagues are open to men and ladies of any standard who are members of the sports club. Each League consist of three or four players and are the best of two sets. Further details on how to join and what the rules are can be viewed on the club website, (see back page).

It is compulsory to book the courts through the computerised meter system or by using the online system or calling the club. Court prices can be viewed on the website & notice boards.

Use your fob to enter your account and select your court and relevant time and confirm.



Open the link on the clubs website and enter your username and password. (If you don't have one ask the membership secretary to provide one)

Select your court, time and confirm.

Once you arrive at the club, using your opponents fob complete the booking by placing the fob over the relevant courtside controller box until their name appears. The controllers are located next to the main computerised system.

Two members are normally required to book the court unless a guest is present then one member must use their fob a second time (paying the additional £2 fee for the guest player).

For evening tennis with the lights the courts are set up for 1.5 hour sessions, however you can block book courts at the bar. This would give you continuous lights for three hours.
