Guests:

If a member brings a guest to play out with a club night, then you should pay the guest fee of £2 for adults and £1 for juniors.

We operate friendly Tennis Box Leagues for both seniors and juniors to provide a means of playing tennis when it suits you. The leagues are open to members only and run all year round. Each year the LTA allocate a number of Wimbledon tickets to our club. This year we have been allocated 8 pairs and we will be holding a draw for these on 15th April, therefore if you haven't already added your name to the ballot please do so now by contacting Lister McKiddie.

Tennis Balls

The club currently sell US Open tennis balls for £10 per dozen with £1 of this going to the club. Unfortunately our supplier has raised their prices so once we buy our next batch of balls the price will rise to £11 per dozen. Sorry for the inconvenience but this £1 profit helps us retain our coaching program which keep the juniors involved.

Coaching

The Club Coach is Richard (Richie) Cunningham (richie @hotmail.co.uk).

Tennis coaching is provided for everyone, not just club members, so feel free to bring a friend down to try tennis out. Club members get a reduced rate.

This year the following sessions will be provided:

Junior Classes - £2 for members £3 for non-members.

Tuesday: 4pm to 5pm – Players between 7 and 10yrs (8 Max)

5pm to 6pm – 10yrs and over, Full yellow ball.

6pm to 7pm - Junior performance groups (invitation only 8 players max)

Thursday: 4pm to 5pm – Open to 10yrs and under (8 max) This is a new time.

Saturday: 10am to 11am – Players between 8 & 10yrs who have played before

11am to 12pm – All players 10yrs and over are welcome 12pm to 1pm – Players 8yrs and under who are just starting

Summer Coaching Weeks

This year Richard Cunningham will be running Summer Coaching camps throughout the summer weeks and the price is £5 for the day for members of the club, or £6 for non-members.

The camps will cover at least 4 of the 6 weeks holiday if not all 6 weeks and will be as usual, Monday, Wednesday and Fridays with mini tennis from 10 to 12.30pm and Junior tennis from 1 to 3.30pm. More details to follow.

Adult Coaching

We currently have 1 adult coaching session which runs on a Tuesday from 7pm to 8pm and is geared up for beginners and intermediates. These sessions cost £3 for members and £4 for non-members. The group session starts on 9^{th} April and is run subject to demand.

Individual & group private lessons can be arranged at the convenience of the coach and yourself. (Prices subject to change up or down with advance notice)

Individual junior lessons – £10 per hour

2 player junior lessons – £16 per hour (2 players split cost between them)

Individual adult lessons – £12 per hour

2 player adult lessons – £16 per hour (2 players split cost between them)

We are one of a few tennis clubs in the country that will only charge you for the lessons that you can attend.
